Job Summary:

Reporting to the Water Truck Operator the Water or designate, the Truck Operator Trainee is primarily responsible for assisting the certified Water Truck Operator with bulk water delivery services to water holding tanks in FNNND and non-FNNND residences. The goal of the position is to build capacity in Capital and Infrastructure department and achieve certification to work toward becoming an accredited Water Truck Operator.

Main Duties:

- Must be willing to commit to a training agreement to enroll in a Bulk Water certification course and relevant courses pertaining to water and wastewater.
- Must complete (35) hours of job-training before taking the Bulk Water course.
- Must be willing to train to attain Class 3 Drivers Certification.
- Assists Water Truck Operator in transporting water to pre-determined locations on a regular scheduled basis.
- Assists in ensuring water trucks and warehouse bay are kept clean and tidy at all times.
- Notifies the Water Truck Operator of any obstructions to water delivery access (i.e. vehicles, debris, etc.).

Impact/ Accountability:

This position assists certified Water Truck Operators of water delivery operation. Not abiding by bulk water regulations and procedures and health and safety requirements can impact on the risk of liability and credibility of the Nation and community.

Decision Making:

This position is a trainee position and requires direct supervision and instruction at all times to meet health and safety requirements, maintain consistent schedule and water quality services. Operational and administrative decision making are made by department management personnel.

Qualifications:

1) Education & Experience:

- Grade 10

Has or is willing to achieve the following training courses in:

- Bulk Water Delivery certification (prerequisite must attain 35 hours on the job training first). This includes Yukon Water and Wastewater Operator Program (YWWOP) courses through Yukon University to attain full certification through the Environmental Operator Certification Program (EOCP).
- Class (3) Yukon Driver's License with Air Brakes endorsement.
- Chlorine handling certification.
- Training in propane and confined space operations.
- Workplace Hazardous Material Information System (WHMIS) certification.

2) Specific Skills and Abilities:

- Must be reliable.
- Must have good interpersonal, oral, and written skills.
- Must have the ability to work as a part of a team and maintain cooperative working relationships in a professional manner.
- Ability to train and gain knowledge of modern water and wastewater treatment principles, practices, methods and procedures.
- Ability to maintain confidentiality, empathy, tact, diplomacy.

WORKING CONDITIONS

Below are the following working conditions:

- Some exposure to water, chemicals, hazardous materials, and noise.
- Heavy lifting up to 50 lbs., moving, walking, standing will be required routinely.
- May encounter and work in various elemental extreme conditions, e.g., rain, snow, heat, cold, etc.
- May be required to wear personal protective equipment, e.g., Safety goggles, gloves, masks, etc.
- Manual dexterity requires to operate and calibrate water hose.
- Travels within community boundaries.
